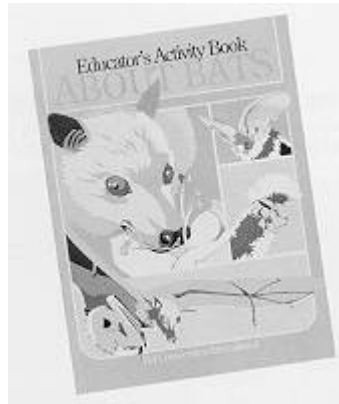

In response to requests from teachers throughout the U.S. and Canada, BCI has recently completed the *Educator's Activity Book About Bats*. This newest educational item for the classroom was developed primarily for youngsters from ages 4-10. It is designed to teach young children the facts about bats before stereotypes become established. Eighteen activities include craft projects such as a bat mobile depicting the diversity of diets, masks of unusual bat faces, a game to teach how mother bats find their babies in a crowded bat roost, a play dealing with what to do when children find a bat on the ground, and many more fun and educational projects. Background information for teachers is included on each topic covered. The BCI member price is \$9.95 plus \$3.75 for shipping and handling.
